In 2016, The Czechoslovak Talks project was launched by the Dotek Endowment Fund. Since 2008, this endowment fund has been involved in activities supporting relations between Czech and Slovaks living abroad and institutions in the Czech Republic and Slovakia (<http://www.dotek.org/cz/projekty>).
